Paris **isn't as warm as** Rome.

6. I think you should tell Isabel. WERE

If **I were you I'd** tell Isabel.

7. I'm going to remove my makeup. TAKE

I'm **going to take off** my makeup.

8. Can you do the dishes for me? MIND

Do **you mind doing** the dishes for me?
